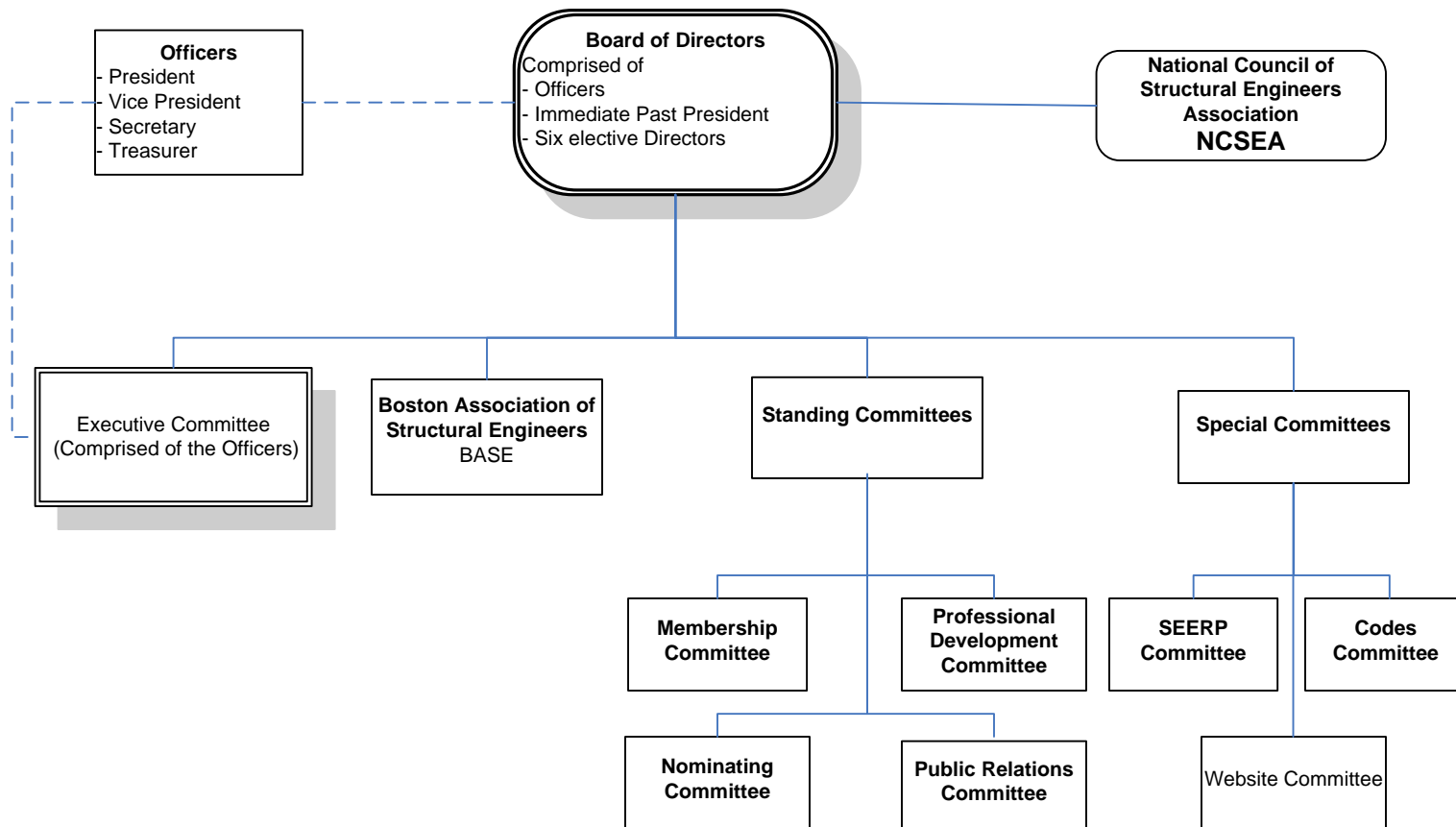

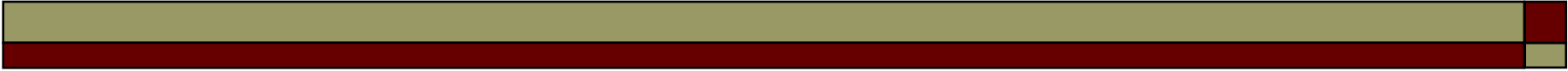




SEAMass



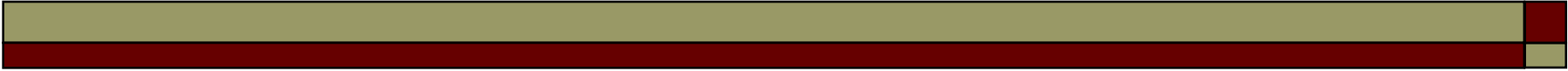

President



Vice President


Fills in when the President needs assistance and if the President is unavailable.

Secretary


Provides notice of meetings and produces notes at all meetings. Maintains papers, letters, and correspondence of SEAMass including the membership database.

Treasurer


Supervision over fiscal affairs. Keeps track of incoming and outgoing funds. Deposits all sums in SEAMass' bank account.

Directors



Professional Development Committee


Provide continuing education programs and maintains relations with institutions that teach structural engineering. It shall promote a minimum education requirement for the practice of structural engineering.

Membership Committee


Recommends qualifications for membership and solicits new members. The committee will also establish application procedures.

Nominating Committee


Select leadership roles for coming year.

Public Relations Committee


Communicate the ethics, standards, goals and accomplishments of SEAMass to structural engineers, related professionals, government and the public.


