We also ask that you take this opportunity to pack and/or review the contents of your go-bag and re-familiarize yourself with the ATC-45 Field Manual: Safety Evaluation of Buildings after Windstorms and Floods.

Call to Action

- NCSEA SEER has received a deployment request from the Building Officials Association of Florida for Longboat Key near Sarasota, Florida.
- They are seeking individuals to provide post disaster building safety evaluation. Requirements include building assessment certification (ICC When Disaster Strikes or CalOES SAP) and individuals must provide their own vehicle, phone, & PPE. If possible a tablet is preferred.
- The requested operational period is 1-2 weeks and would start as Tuesday October 15, 2024.
- Travel reimbursements are not included, however, a hotel may be provided.
- For those available to volunteer please respond to this email and we will coordinate additional details with you directly.

This is NOT a deployment notice. This email serves only to provide basic information about the current request. Follow up details will be provided if you respond that you are available. At no time should any individual self-deploy without further instructions.
